



PROGRAMS

All programs are free and take place at the Waldport Community Learning Center.

EDUCATION

Adult Literacy

One-to-one tutoring and learn-to-read sessions are available to adults at all stages of learning. Available as needed.

After-School Homework Help

Adult volunteer/mentors are paired with students to offer care, attention and academic guidance. Available for all ages. Mon - Fri, 3-5:30pm.

Enrichment Classes

In partnership with the 21st Century Community Learning Centers, Seashore offers afterschool enrichment classes. Mon - Fri, 3:30-5:30.

Jo-Ralph Playgroup

This early literacy program aims for "accidental learning" opportunities through music, movement and games. Meets Mon and Fri, 10am - noon.

Project JOY

Job Opportunities for Youth offers teens paid, on-the-job training and business building skills. JOY projects include the Boss Bags business, and hands-on learning in the Learning Center kitchen. JOY offers teens a combination of creativity, experience and income.

School Supply Drive & Giveaway

An annual fall event to collect donations of critically needed school supplies that are then distributed, at no cost, to Lincoln County students in need.

Summer Camps

Summer day camps offer youth entertaining and educational activities in the areas of music, art, science, math, reading, writing and more. Free breakfast and lunch included.

Volunteer Training

Seashore values its volunteers! Comprehensive training is provided quarterly, along with CPR and Food Handler classes.

Writing Groups

With an emphasis on self-expression, students improve reading, writing and social skills as they share their work, engage in discussions, and experience peer-to-peer feedback in a fun and supportive group setting.

Young Writers (for high school age) meets on Thursdays, 6 - 8pm for dinner, creative writing and mentor support.

The Writing Club (for middle school age), and Happy Hour (for grade school), is offered by Seashore in partnership with the 21st Century After School Program.



FOOD & CLOTHING

After School Snacks

The Seashore kitchen — with job-training teens — produces scores of healthy snacks for youngsters enrolled in the after school program.

Clothes Closet

Offering free, clean, used clothing for all ages, this resource serves hundreds of people monthly. It is located in the Waldport Community Learning Center cafeteria and is open to the public Saturdays from 8:30 -10:30am, and Wednesdays 9 -11am, and by appointment.

Family Literacy Night Dinner

Serving free, hot and healthy dinners to the community, along with books, reading and games for the whole family. Held the second Wednesday of every month, at 6pm.

Saturday Breakfast

Dozens of volunteers work together to provide hot breakfast to over 50 people each week. Breakfast is free and open to all. Every Saturday, 9:30 -10am.

Summer Food Program

In a partnership with the USDA Summer Food Program, Seashore provides the community free and nutritious breakfasts and lunches.

COMMUNITY - RECREATION

Conversations that Matter

A thoughtful gathering for intellectual discussion on social and political topics. Public is welcome. Meets Tuesdays at 7pm.

Green Bikes

Promoting health and recreation, the Green Bikes program provides over 100 bikes for anyone to ride, anytime, to any destination — no questions asked. A corps of adult and youth volunteers collect, paint, repair and maintain an inventory of over 100 bikes in Waldport and Yachats.

Seashore Literacy Garden

The garden is a gathering place and outdoor learning space, serving as “class-room” for hands-on lessons in science, environment, arts, writing, and more.
